Funds are disbursed after each meeting.

The Foundation does **not** fund grant requests for the following:

- Individuals
- Salaries
- Multi-year grants
- Major capital projects
- Substance abuse programs
- Endowments
- Religious organizations for religious purposes
- Political entities
- National organizations, even if for local projects
- Private foundations
- Organizations outside the State of Kentucky

Deadlines:

Grant proposals must be submitted by March 1st or September 1st. Applications are considered in April and October. Applicants are notified in writing of the approval or denial of funding. An unsuccessful application does not reflect on the worthiness of a particular project. The Foundation receives more requests than it can fund.

HOW TO APPLY:

Log in to the grant portal to download the application, complete, and upload it along with the following:

1. Letter outlining proposal
2. Budget for project
3. List of current Board members
4. Audited financial statement or most recent annual report
5. IRS tax determination letter

The Board may request additional information or make arrangements for an on-site visit. Multi-year grant requests must be resubmitted annually.

A report on the use of the grant is required within one year from the date of issue. If the grant cannot be expended within a year, a written request must be made for an extension of time. If you are unable to use the grant for the purpose approved, the grant must be returned.
